Project objectives

- 1. Identification of structures and problems of the Ukrainian vocational education system
- 2. Identifying the system of teacher education for VET
- 3. Implementing innovative course structures and didactical innovations in the field of teacher training based on innovative teaching and learning theories
- 4. Implementing new forms of cooperation between university and schools/ colleges and exploring new ways/ fields to acquire premature professional experience outside the classroom

Outcomes

- 1. Structured report on the VET system of Ukraine and its specific problems
- 2. Structured report on the Ukrainian teacher education system and its specific problems
- 3. New curricula for the pedagogical/ didactical part of teacher education courses at the Ukrainian partner universities
- 4. New regulations and agreements between universities, schools/ colleges and institutions outside the education system with respect to experience based components of teacher education
