WU in the Financial Times ranking: Master in International Management at 24th and CEMS at 2nd place

WU placed well again in this year's recently published 2010 Financial Times Masters in Management ranking: WU's Master in International Management was ranked 24th of the 65 programs evaluated. This puts WU at 4th place among German-speaking universities. International mobility, the improved qualifications of WU's faculty and value for money were all points in WU's favor in this year's ranking.

The CEMS program, a joint degree program held in cooperation with 24 international universities and available in Austria exclusively at WU, came in at an excellent 2nd place in the prestigious ranking, putting it

in the top three again this year. In addition to the high salaries earned by program graduates and their excellent acceptance on the labor market, the high level of internationality of both the curriculum and the participants were factors contributing to these successful results.
