PROFESSOR GRYGORII PUGACHEVSKYI CELEBRATED HIS 75 BIRTHDAY

Grygorii Pugachevskyi, vice-president of IGWT, professor of the Department of Science of Commodities and Expertise of Nonfood Goods of Kiev National University of Trade and Economics (KNUTE) is 75 on the 13th of April 2010.



Professor Grygorii Pugachevskyi devoted all his life to the development of science and training specialists in Science of Commodities. Professor Pugachevskyi is actively doing scientific and methodical work at the Department of Science of Commodities and in the university. He initiated the development of a new specialization in training specialists in "Science of Commodities and foreign trade organization"

Scientific achievements of professor are rather weighty: he is the author of more than 200 scientific works, more than 50 scientific-methodical works (developing), 4 text-books, 2 monographs, 3 study guides (work books) 2 patents for inventions and he is also the developer of normative documents. For his weighty achievements he was awarded the title "Honorary worker of Science and Technology of Ukraine" and the "Badge of Honor". He is full member of Ukrainian Technological Academy.

Grygorii Pugachevskyi is the founder of the school in the problem of theoretical and special science of commodities, leader of scientific school in the sphere of formation of properties, assortment and quality of textile product. He prepared 17 candidates and doctors of sciences (technology).

Professor Pugachevskyi is the head of the specialized academic council for the defence of candidate and doctor theses, he is the member of Academic Council of Science of Commodities Faculty and Academic Council of Kiev National University of Trade and Economics, a member of the additional board of scientific journal "Visnyk KNUTE" and international scientific practical journal "Commodities and Markets", a member of section of commodity experts of Scientific-Methodical Commission of Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine - Trade direction.

Scientific achievements of professor Pugachevskyi are recognized and appreciated by the world commodity experts' society, in 2004–2006 he was elected the Pre-President and in 2006–2008 he was elected the President of International Association of Commodity Experts and Technologists of IGWT. Professor Pugachevskyi has been the vice-president of this authoritative international organization since 2008.

Grygorii Pugachevskyi is the leading and recognized scientist in the world in the sphere of science of commodities, a highly educated and cultured person, who enjoys universal esteem among Ukrainian and foreign colleagues.
