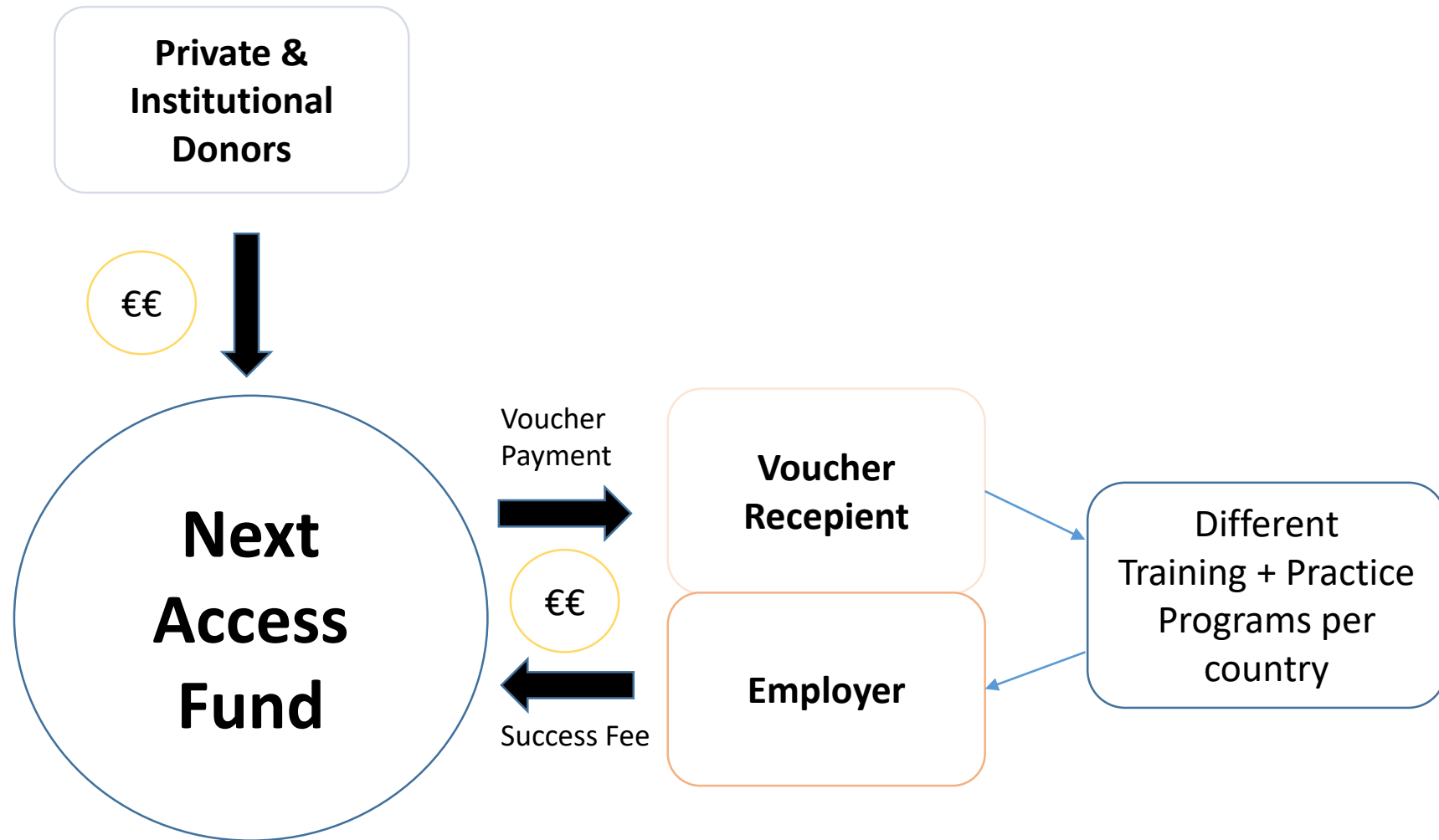

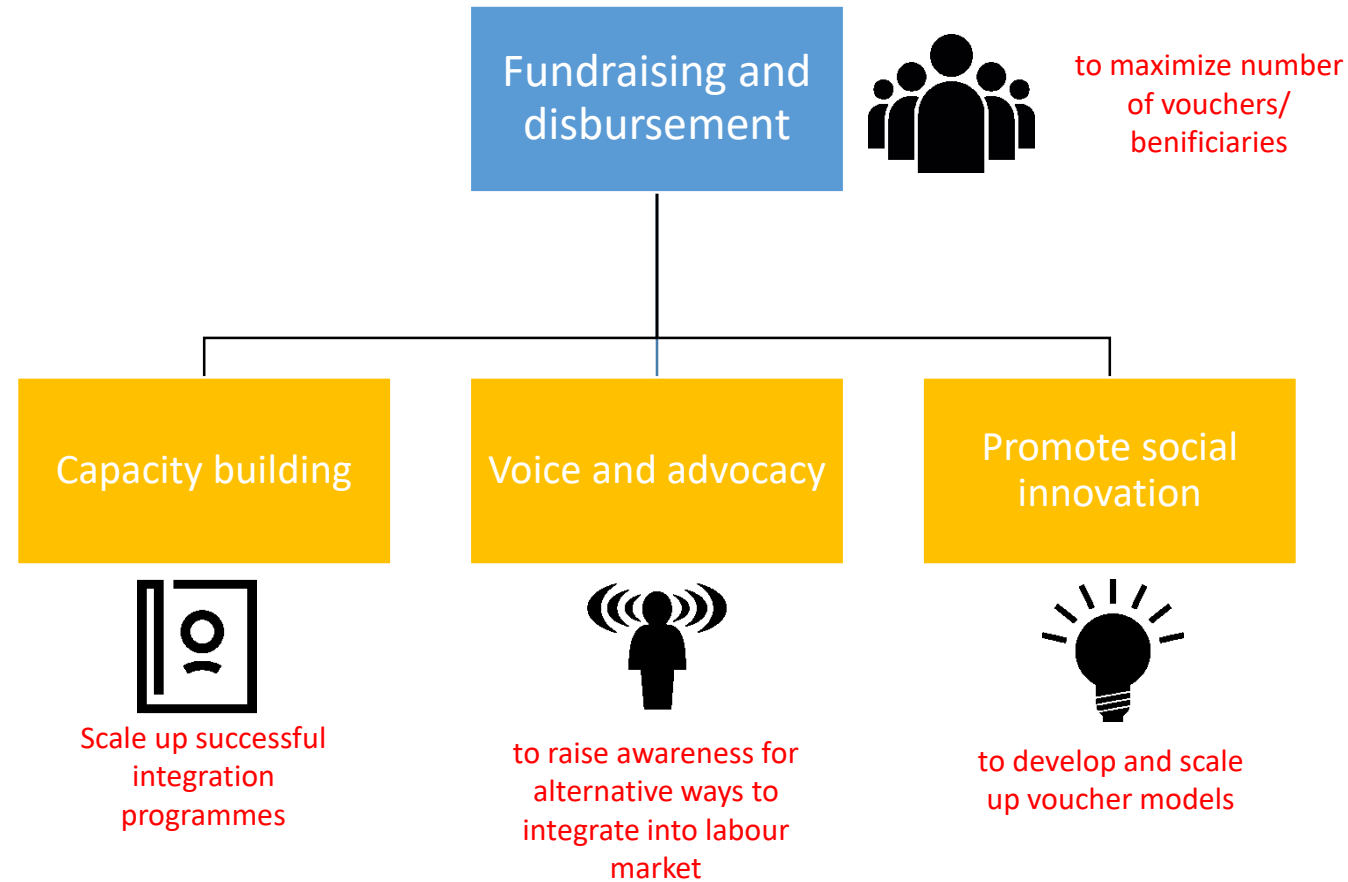

Reasons to found an European Cooperative Society:

- to facilitate the cross-border cooperation between partners from more than one EU country.
- possibility of involving strategic partners from different European countries in various roles.
- enabling the combination of social and economic objectives in a balanced way
- a pan-European approach, ensuring consistency throughout the EU-states

Failed because of

- Little know-how and competences in founding an SCE
- Only a few best-practice examples
- Business Model was not supposed to fulfil legal requirements
- Legal restrictions regarding of financial transfer (BAFIN)

Why we choose the Trust Agreement

- Legal framework is more flexible
- Shorter process of founding
- Can be easily adapted
- Pilot structure in order to gain experience

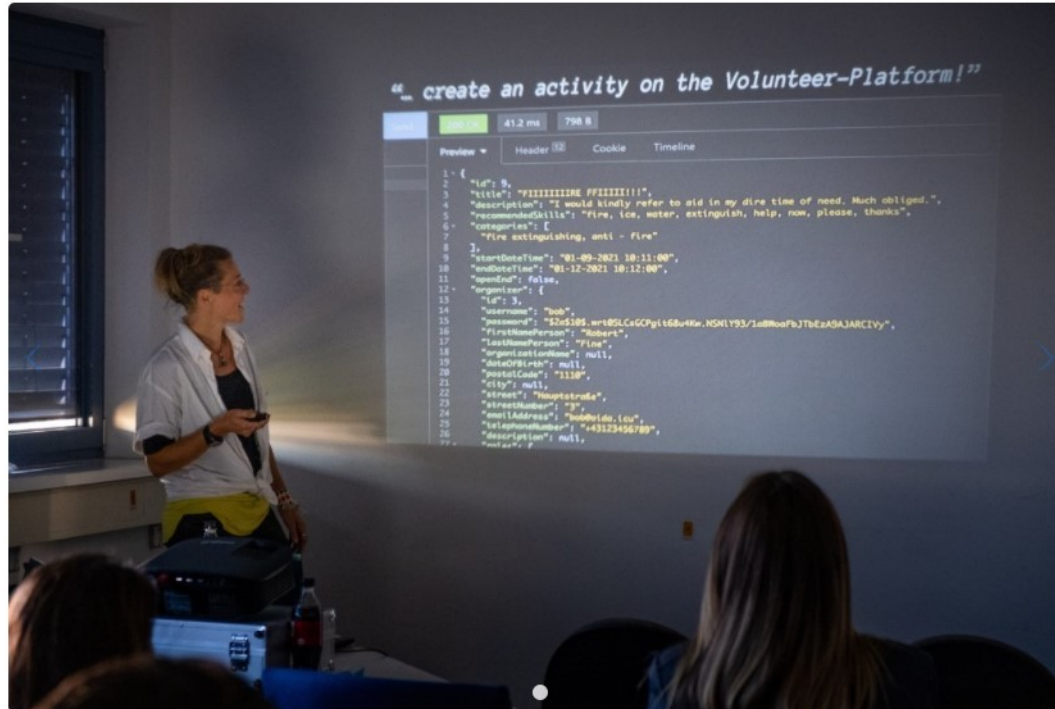

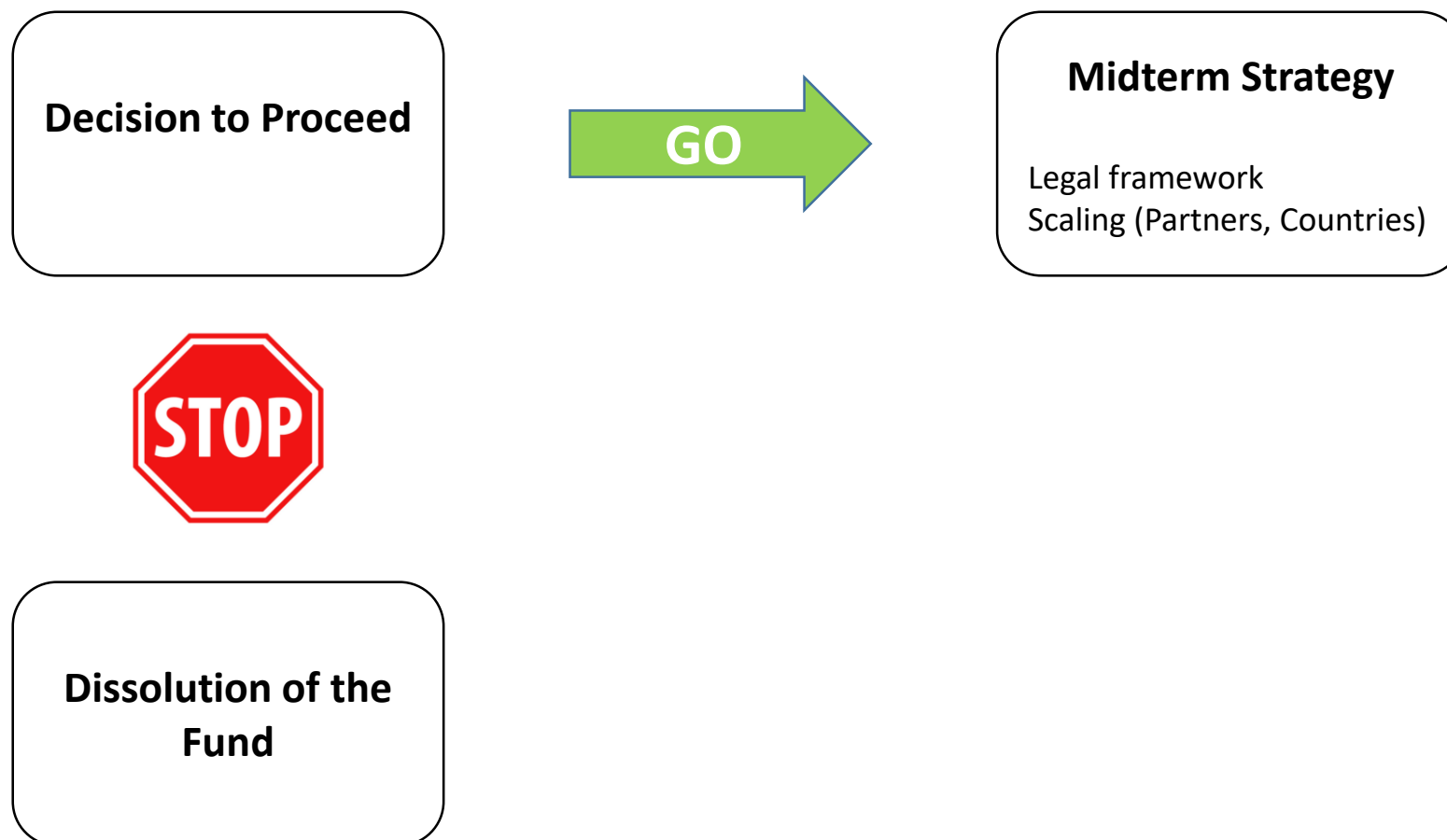
