Dr. Lina Triana is the President of the International Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (ISAPS) and a plastic surgeon based in Cali (Colombia), treating patients from all around the world. She is committed to working to improve patients' safety in aesthetic plastic surgery worldwide.
