Francisco O. Ramirez is Professor of Education and (by courtesy) Sociology at Stanford University. His current research interests focus on the worldwide rationalization of university structures and processes and on terms of inclusion issues as regards gender and education. Recent publications may be found in Comparative Education, Comparative Education Review, Social Forces, and International Sociology. Ramirez is also the co-editor of Universities as Agencies: Reputation and Professionalization (2019).

His work has contributed to the development of the world society perspective in the social sciences and in international comparative education. Ramirez is the Director of the Scandinavian Consortium for Organizational Studies at the Graduate School of Education at Stanford. He has been a fellow at the Center for the Advanced Studies of the Behavioral Sciences (2006-07) and at the Swedish Collegium for Advanced Studies (2017).
