Claudia Fuchs has been Professor of Public Law at the Vienna University of Economics and Business since October 2023. She served as Head of the Institute for Austrian and European Public Law and currently holds the position of Head of the Department of Public law and Tax Law.

Prior to this appointment, she served as Professor of Public Law at Johannes Kepler University Linz, where she also headed the Department of Public Corporate Law.

Her research interests lie in constitutional and administrative law, public economic law, and public law adjudication. A particular focus of her work is on public procurement law, state aid and public funding law, regulatory law, procedural law, and comparative constitutional law.

Claudia Fuchs has held numerous research and teaching fellowships, including a visiting fellowship at the Department of Law of the London School of Economics and Political Science and a research fellowship at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law in Heidelberg.
