### **PAVEL CASTKA:**

### **SOCIAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING IN SUPPLY CHAINS – TOWARDS TRANSFORMATIVE TRANSPARENCY**

From the use of remote auditing practices (and rudimentary ICT) to use of drones, satellites or AI, the COVID-19 pandemic has accelerated innovation and adoption of technologies for monitoring practices in global supply chains. Prof Castka will discuss implications of these changes for social and environmental transparency in supply chains and will outline a concept of transformative transparency. The seminar builds on his current projects funded by New Zealand government and international agencies.

**Prof. Pavel Castka, PhD, M** is Associate Dean Research and Professor of Supply Chain Management and Sustainability at UC Business School, University of Canterbury, New Zealand. He is a member of various committees at International Organization for Standardization (ISO) His current projects focus on stakeholder engagement in monitoring practices in the context of modern slavery, farm monitoring as well as socio-technical perspectives on the use of satellites and automated monitoring in agribusiness.
