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Conference main theme

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is disrupting teaching and learning. Tremendous technological developments have opened up new opportunities but also confront us with challenges.

The theme of the *Future of Teaching and Learning Conference* is dedicated to the discussion of AI applications in (Project) Management Learning and Teaching and takes place on 2 and 3 May 2024 at WU Vienna.

We will share our results of the ERASMUS+ project ChatLearn, showcase it and discuss with you our experience gained in developing a personalized chatbot for learning project management.

We invite you to engage in a discussion about current developments and trends, critically discuss opportunities and challenges.

Possible subthemes

- The overarching conference theme explores the transformative impact of AI on education, unveiling new and disruptive opportunities for teaching and learning.
- Learning occurs not only within universities but also in schools, associations, and business. Therefore, we are keenly interested in the transformative effects of AI in learning (project) management in the aforementioned educational levels, as well as within associations and companies.
- AI can play a crucial role in enabling learning from past projects. Therefore, we are interested in papers exploring how AI can support the process of learning across projects by analyzing historical project data, identifying patterns, and extracting valuable insights from past experiences.
- Other AI application in company context, for example strategic decision making, portfolio decision making, AI applications in onboarding.

Conference format

You have the possibility of sharing your knowledge and experience on AI applications in education and learning, network with educators, trainers, learners and practitioners, and further develop your knowledge on this future oriented topic.

The conference is targeted to a wide audience including academics, trainers, consultants as well as company representatives interested in sharing their developments.

The conference features keynotes, panel discussions, paper presentations, and posters. As presenter, you need to be on site. For **remote** participants who would like to engage online, we will offer a **hybrid possibility** to engage in the main activities.

Submission of proposals

You are invited to submit a proposal for a **paper**, a **poster**, a **panel** or a **workshop** on a topic that is relevant to the conference theme. A **paper** presentation refers to a presentation delivered by one or several authors on a particular research topic. A **poster** presentation is generally suitable for preliminary studies or early stage projects. A **panel** generally comprises a series of 3-4 presentations on a common topic delivered by a group of people facilitated by a moderator. For a panel format, a joint proposal is expected. A **workshop** is an interactive format with presentations, demonstrations and discussions by a group of people, facilitated by 1-2 moderators. For a workshop format, a joint proposal is expected.

For submission, please use the templates available on our website below. More detailed instructions on what is expected for each submission format is provided in the templates. Abstracts for all formats need to follow the structure provided in the templates and should not exceed 1000 words.
