## **Bernhard Mahlberg**

After completing compulsory schooling, Bernhard Mahlberg attended a higher technical college for electrical communications engineering and electronics in Vienna. After graduating from college, he studied sociology at the University of Vienna from 1990 to 1993 (including the first diploma examination) and from 1990 to 1996 computational economics at the University of Vienna and the Technical University of Vienna (graduated with a "Master of Social and Economic Sciences"). He then completed his doctorate at the University of Vienna until 1999 (graduating with a "Doctor of Social and Economic Sciences"). His dissertation quantified the effects of the European single market on Austrian and German insurance companies.

Since 2002 he has been an researcher as well as a political and business consultant at the Institute for Industrial Research (IWI) in Vienna. At this institute he is employed in various research projects in which quantitative methods of empirical economic research are used. Before joining the IWI, he gained several years of experience at the Vienna University of Economics and Business (as an research assistant at the Department of Economics and as an assistant professor at the Research Institute for European Affairs) and at the Austrian Institute for Economic Research (WIFO). The main focus of Mr. Mahlberg's research is currently in the areas of efficiency and productivity analyzes, energy and environmental economics, Austria's international competitiveness, macroeconomic consequences of digitization and the consequences of demographic change. In addition to his work at the IWI, Mr. Mahlberg as an external lecturer at the Vienna University of Economics and Business (basics of scientific work, efficiency and productivity analysis, ...).

Membership in various national and international scientific organizations, persentations at international scientific conferences and publications in internationally recognized journals round off his profile.
