History

- started 1995
 - "Neseksistična raba jezika" (ed. Kozmik & Jeram)
 - "Razmerje med spolom kot potezo reference in spolom kot slovnično kategorijo" (Kunst-Gnamuš)
- steady presence in linguistics (and sociology)
- political measures until 2008
 - Standardna klasifikacija poklicev, Nomotehnične smernice





Topics treated

- non sexist language use (grammatical and referential gender)
 - address, forms of reference, masculine generics; female personal nouns (word formation, lexicography)
- stereotypes in lexicology/lexicography and phraseology
- gender-specific language use
- gender(ed) discourse





Types of publications

- no published monographies
- articles (in journals and edited volumes)
- diploma / master theses
 - interest among students
- little international presence





Theoretical development

- mostly descriptive
- little theoretical entrenchment
- traditional theoretical standpoints

- Metastudies on the basis of existing investigations (diploma and master theses)
- larger-scale specialized studies addressing the following topics:





Topics to be investigated

- The representation of gender (men, women, queer, trans ...) on the textual and discourse levels
 - job advertisments
 - media
 - forms of reference and address
 - comparison between different historical periods





Topics to be investigated

- Word formation
 - female personal nouns (formation rules and productivity)
- Lexicology
 - full picture of the lexical field
 - social gender
 - stereotypes, connotations





Topics to be investigated

- Psycholinguistic effects of masculine generics and other discriminatory language usage
- Language policy
