

Call for Papers:

The Doctoral Program in International Business Taxation at WU Vienna (DIBT) and its two business faculty members, Prof. Eva Eberhartinger and Prof. Caren Sureth-Sloane are happy to announce the 3rd Doctoral Research Seminar, which will be held at WU Vienna on October 20 and 21, 2016. The seminar offers an excellent opportunity for PhD-students and Post-Doctoral researchers to discuss current research and to receive constructive feedback on their research projects. The submitted work shall have a strong focus on international business taxation and approach research questions from a management perspective. In particular, this includes topics of supra-national relevance.

Programme:

The Doctoral Research Seminar will be divided into two streams with a varying composition of the discussion plenum. In the junior stream of the seminar, senior researchers will not participate which should create a more protected environment for presentation and discussion. Therein, every paper session involves 15 minutes of presentation which will be followed by a discussion through a pre-assigned discussant (15 minutes). The remaining time will be dedicated to an open discussion (20 minutes). In total 50 minutes are reserved for each paper.







In contrast to the junior stream, senior researchers will take part in the senior stream of the seminar. The basic setup is similar as a 15 minute presentation of the research project will be followed by a 20 minute discussion through a pre-assigned discussant, and by an open discussion (25 minutes). In total this leaves 60 minutes per paper. Please note that the junior stream will be held on the morning of the first seminar day (20th October) while the following one and a half days will be dedicated to the senior stream of the seminar.

Participation is free of charge. Please note that funding is not available, participants are eypected to cover their expenses.

The entire Doctoral Research Seminar will be held in English.

Submission Guidelines:

The submission shall include a cover page and a research proposal. The cover page shall include the title of the paper and a list of all (co)-authors together with their affiliation. The research proposal shall consist of an extended abstract of roughly one or two pages including: Motivation, Research Question(s), Method, Research Gap and Contribution. Additionally, researchers are encouraged to submit a (preliminary) full paper accompanying their research proposal if available. The submission should indicate preference for junior or senior stream.

Notification of Acceptance: 21nd June 2016

Submission of Final Papers: 28th September 2016
