The Hoops Tax Institute in the Carson College of Business at Washington State University seeks a post-doctorate researcher. The anticipated starting date is August 16, 2018. This position is for one year, with the possibility of renewal for a second year based on mutual agreement.

**Qualifications:**

Candidates for the post-doctorate research position must possess an earned Ph.D. in accounting or economics from a nationally or internationally recognized university by employment start date. An interest in, and commitment to, high-quality scholarly tax research is also required.

**Job Duties:**

The holder of this position will conduct joint research with academics currently associated with the Hoops Tax Institute. No teaching is expected of this post-doctorate researcher. This position will have WRDS access to a range of databases including Compustat, CRSP, BoardEx, and I/B/E/S, among many others.

The nine-month compensation is expected to be \$55,000 plus a \$5,000 research and travel allowance.

**University/College:**

Washington State University conducts transformational research and provides world-class education to more than 30,000 undergraduate, graduate, and professional students. Founded in 1890 in Pullman, it is Washington's original land-grant university. The Carson College of Business is AACSB accredited with a research oriented faculty. It first offered a business administration degree in 1940. Today, the college grants almost 20 percent of WSU's undergraduate degrees, making business one of the most popular majors on campus.

**Community:**

The communities of Pullman, Washington and Moscow, Idaho, each contain a major state university and are located eight miles apart in the scenic Palouse Hills area of eastern Washington and northern Idaho. The combined population is approximately 56,000, including 41,000 students.
