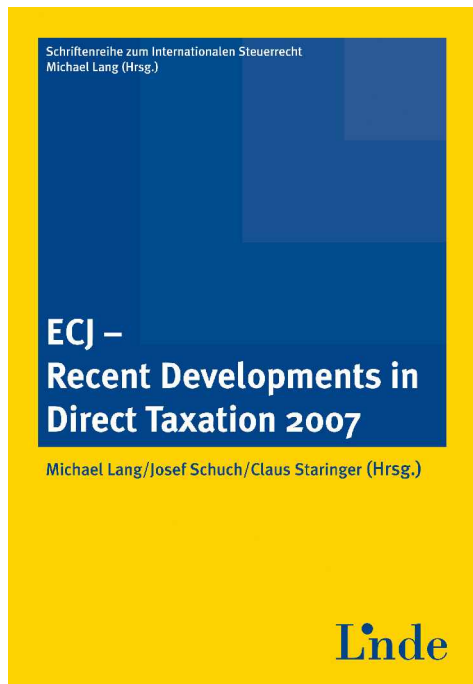


# Results of the Conference on Recent and Pending Cases at the ECJ on Direct Taxation
