Seminar Tax Compliance with **Microsoft Power Platform Applications**



October 19-21, 2022 • Vienna







Abstract

In recent years, Microsoft Power Business Intelligence (BI) has emerged as an agile and cost-effective approach to automation with which digital transformation projects can be delivered. The MS Power Platform will now enable even more automation for accounting, taxes and customs applications. Analytics and business intelligence (ABI) platforms enable less technical users, including businesspeople, to model, analyze, explore, share and manage data, and collaborate and share findings, enabled by IT and augmented by artificial intelligence (AI). ABI platforms may optionally include the ability to create, modify or enrich a semantic model including business rules. Many platforms are adding capabilities for users to easily compose low-code or no-code automation workflows and applications. This blend of capabilities is helping to expand the vision for analytics beyond simply delivering datasets and presenting dashboards to delivering enriched contextualized insights, refocusing attention on decision-making processes, and ultimately taking actions that will deliver business value. Based on Power BI, digital innovations from areas such as ML/AI or block chain can also be interwoven with existing applications. Thus, Power BI as part of the MS Power Platform also offers itself as a framework for bringing digital innovations from the laboratory into practice.

General Information

The seminar **lasts** three days and takes place in Vienna from **October 19-21, 2022**. The seminar is entirely held in **English**.

The course is structured into four sessions per day of 1.5 hours each. The topics are analyzed with a mix of theory and project work with expert coaching.





Target Group

The seminar is targeted at professionals around the world who want to broaden their knowledge of tax law technology i.e. digitalization and automation. Participants typically are in-house tax & customs and finance employees of international companies, government officials, and academics, tax & customs advisers (accountants, economists, and lawyers).

Seminar Level

The seminar starts at a tax **expert level**. However, deep tax knowledge is not required. Hence, it can be attended by both participants with basic experiences in tax law technology and participants with expert experiences in this field. No advance preparation is required.
