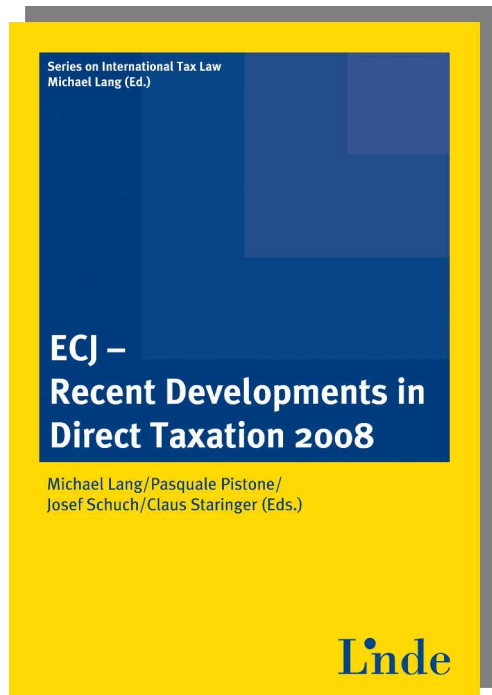


Recent and Pending Cases at the ECJ on Direct Taxation
