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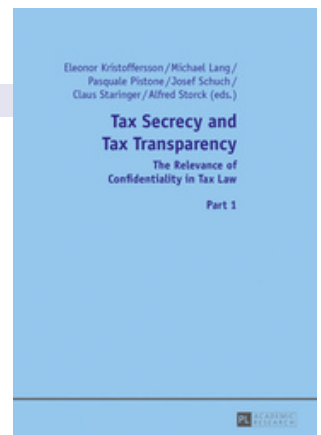
Tax Secrecy and Tax Transparency

The issue of tax secrecy and tax transparency plays a significant role not only in academics, but also in general practice. The aim of this book is to analyze the approaches taken by different countries to confidentiality arrangements in tax law.
