



Licence Terms and Conditions for the German Version of ASCOT

These Terms and Conditions have been prepared in German and English. In case of disputes and questions of interpretation arising from these Terms and Conditions, the German version shall prevail.

These Terms and Conditions supplement the conditions set forth in the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM for the application for a licence to use the German version of ASCOT

concluded between

1. "LICENSEE" (as defined in the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM)

and

2. "WU" Vienna University of Economics and Business (Wirtschaftsuniversität Wien) with its registered address at Welthandelsplatz 1, 1020 Vienna, Austria;

together referred to as the "PARTIES".

Background

The Adult Social Care Outcomes Toolkit (ASCOT) was developed by members of the Personal Social Service Research Unit (PSSRU) at the University of Kent. The WU's ASCOT team, based at the WU Research Institute for Economics of Aging, has produced an authorized German translation of the English ASCOT instruments (ASCOT INT4 and SCT4; ASCOT-Carer INT4 and SCT4). The WU has all necessary rights, which the LICENSEE wishes to acquire as set forth in this agreement.

The PARTIES agree as follows:

1 Definitions

In this LICENCE AGREEMENT, the following words shall have the following meanings:

ASCOT-WEBSITE (WU)	https://www.wu.ac.at/en/altersoekonomie/ascot
GERMAN ASCOT:	The German translation of the Adult Social Care Outcomes Toolkit, i.e. the German translation of ASCOT MEASURES (ASCOT (SCT4, INT4) and ASCOT-Carer (SCT4, INT4)) as selected in the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM.
GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM:	The fully completed "Application for a licence for the German version of ASCOT" form outlining the PROJECT, to which these Terms and Conditions are attached.
GERMAN ASCOT MEASURE(S):	The specific German ASCOT measure or measures named in the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM, such as: ASCOT (SCT4, INT4) and ASCOT-Carer (SCT4, INT4).
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS:	Patents, rights to inventions, trademarks, service marks, registered designs, copyrights and related rights, database rights, design rights, rights to use and protect confidential information, in each case whether registered or unregistered, including rights to apply for and be granted and applications for any of the above and any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisional applications, renewals or extensions of, and rights to claim priority from, those rights, and any similar right recognised from time to time in any jurisdiction, together with all rights of action in relation to the infringement of any of the above
LICENCE AGREEMENT	The GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM approved by the WU together with these Licence Terms and Conditions for the GERMAN ASCOT constitute the whole LICENCE AGREEMENT. Both the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM and these Licence Terms and Conditions have been prepared in German and English. In case of disputes and questions of interpretation arising from these documents, the German version shall prevail.
LICENCE PERIOD:	The period set out in the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM and approved by WU.
NOT-FOR-PROFIT USE:	Any non-profit organisation or public organisation/authority that requires GERMAN ASCOT for its own use. This means that GERMAN ASCOT is used for the benefit of the public without financial gain. Examples of NOT-FOR-PROFIT USE include but are not limited to: (1) A local authority, public sector organisation or registered charity/non-profit organisation wishes to use GERMAN ASCOT for care service quality monitoring or for measuring the effects of their care services. (2) Use of the GERMAN ASCOT by a not-for-profit business. This includes academic institutions.
	In the case that it is unclear whether the proposed use of ASCOT requires a FOR-PROFIT or NOT-FOR-PROFIT licence, the LICENSEE must first receive a confirmation of the type of licence from the WU (ascot-deutsch@wu.ac.at) before submitting the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM.
FOR-PROFIT USE:	Any for-profit organisation that requires GERMAN ASCOT for its own commercial use. In this context, commercial use means any use that supports the generation of revenue including but not limited to: (1) any use in support of an application for regulatory approval for a product or service;

USERS:	Employees, students or visiting researchers of the LICENSEE.
TERRITORY/FIELD:	Territorial and factual area of use of the GERMAN VERSION OF ASCOT in TERRITORY as specified in the GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM and accepted by WU. In any case, the factual use of GERMAN ASCOT is limited to the field of long-term care of adults and to the use with German-speaking respondents.
PROJECT:	The project or study that uses the GERMAN VERSION OF ASCOT as set out in GERMAN-ASCOT REGISTRATION FORM and accepted by the WU.
PSSRU:	The Personal Social Services Research Unit at the University of Kent.
	This does not apply to non-profit organisations or organisations of the public sector.

2 Grant

2.1 Licence.	a. When accepting in writing the application of the LICENSEE to use GERMAN ASCOT according to the information provided within the GERMAN ASCOT

	c. GERMAN ASCOT has been developed to be used in adult social care/long-term care service provision and shall only be used for that purpose.	
	d. Where appropriate, the LICENSEE shall explain the USERS the use of the GERMAN ASCOT MEASURE(S) prior to using it.	
	e. For any proposed new PROJECT using the GERMAN ASCOT, the LICENSEE shall acquire a new licence.	
2.2 Access.	a. Licences granted under this LICENCE AGREEMENT are personal to LICENSEE and cannot be shared with any other individual or organisation, unless otherwise provided in this LICENCE AGREEMENT.	
	b. The LICENSEE shall ensure that the GERMAN VERSION OF ASCOT is used only for the agreed purpose, in the licensed scope and only by authorized USERS. LICENSEE shall supervise the use of GERMAN ASCOT, control access to it and	
	keep it secure.	
	c. The LICENSEE remains fully responsible at all times for all acts and omissions of USERS and for ensuring such persons understand and observe this Licence.	
2.3 Confidentiality.	a. The LICENSEE acknowledges that GERMAN ASCOT is confidential.	
	b. Unless required to disclose by law or in connection with legal proceedings, the LICENSEE shall keep GERMAN ASCOT confidential and secret, together with all INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS, know-how, techniques, ideas, principles and concepts which underlie GERMAN ASCOT and all information disclosed by WU in relation to GERMAN ASCOT or which is otherwise identified as confidential.	
	c. The obligations in this clause do not apply to information which is in or becomes part of the public domain in a lawful manner.	
	d. The provisions of this clause shall survive the expiry or earlier termination of the LICENCE PERIOD for a period of 15 years.

	d. The Licence does not include the provision of support or training for the use of the GERMAN ASCOT MEASURE(S), except for basic technical or use queries. Any further support or training is available on request to WU on a consultancy basis. Such additional support may be subject to a separate agreement specific to the support agreed.

4.2 Termination of the LICENCE AGREEMENT by WU (tbc)	a. The WU may terminate prematurely the LICENCE AGREEMENT and without notice in writing if the LICENSEE fails to comply with any provision of this Licence, within 14 calendar days of being required to do so by written notice.
