Selection procedure for the Bachelor's Program in Business, Economics and Social Sciences

WU's Bachelor's Program in Business, Economics and Social Sciences has a capacity of 3,674 students per academic year. May 15 was the online pre-registration deadline for students interested in starting the program in the 2015/16 academic year. WU received a total of 4,630 pre-registrations, far exceeding the available capacity, which means that a two-stage selection procedure will be conducted.

Prospective students interested in starting the Bachelor's Program in Business, Economics and Social Sciences in the fall of 2015 or the spring of 2016 were required to pre-register online. The total number of pre-registrations received exceeded the available capacity by 956 applicants, which means that WU will be conducting a two-stage selection procedure.

Letter of motivation and entrance exam

During the first stage of the selection procedure, from May 18 to May 31, prospective students are required to upload a letter of motivation. The second stage is an entrance exam, scheduled to be held in Vienna on July 7, 2015 at 10:00am.

The entire selection procedure is conducted in German. Sufficient German skills are essential for all prospective students interested in enrolling in the Bachelor's Program in Business, Economics and Social Sciences.
