

Information on permitted calculators

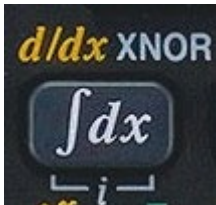
Entrance exam for the Bachelor's Program in Business and Economics, Academic year 2026/27



In principle, all calculators are permitted in the exam. However, they **must not have any additional functions** that allow:

- solving linear equation systems,
- multiplying matrices,
- differentiating or integrating functions.

Calculators with text memory are also prohibited.



If your calculator has a key like the one shown in the illustration on the left or a similar one, then its use is not permitted.

Permitted calculators include, for example:

- Texas Instruments TI-30XS MultiView
- Texas Instruments TI-30X Plus MultiView
- Texas Instruments TI-30X Plus MathPrint
- Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS

Please note: The Texas Instruments TI-30X Pro MathPrint is not permitted.

Notes:

If you are unsure whether your calculator is permitted or not, please refer to the calculator's operating instructions. If you no longer have these, you can easily obtain them online. Calculators will be checked during the exam. Anyone caught using a calculator with unauthorized functions will be excluded from the exam and thus from the selection procedure. No replacement devices can be provided.
