Dear students,

With this document, we would like to draw your attention to some student support services. These can serve as a resource you can turn to in stressful situations, when you have learning difficulties and problems during your studies, but also in case of harassment or discrimination. The list is certainly not exhaustive but is intended to provide guidance and an overview.

Services offered by WU:

Ombuds Office for Students: advises in case of

- Conflicts in courses, examination situations, admission procedures, etc.
- Conflicts in the thesis writing process; conflicts that may lead to the termination of a thesis supervision agreement
- Providing clarification in cases where different WU bodies have given inconsistent information
- Inappropriate behavior, discrimination or (sexual) harassment in the context of teaching and learning
- Collecting and processing ideas for improving study conditions and services for students

Student Counselling: advises on

- Study-related problems, conflicts and crises
- Psycho-social problems affecting students' quality of life and performance potential
- Challenging social situations, such as the reconciliation of studies, work, and family
- Doubts about the study/choice of study
- Feelings of insecurity and fear, also regarding life after graduation

BeAble: for WU students with disabilities and/or chronic illnesses.

<u>Equal Opportunities Committee</u>: has the task of counteracting any discrimination on the grounds of disability, sex, ethnic origin, religion, belief, age, or sexual orientation by university governing bodies, and to advise and support university members and bodies concerning such issues.
