

Small-scale projects by WU junior faculty

Objective: The objective is to generate research data as part of an independent research project.

Maximum funding per application: € 5,000.00

Requirements: The preferred target group is junior researchers currently employed at WU. Post Docs and Senior Post Docs (with habilitation) are excluded from this funding scheme.

New: In the event of insufficient funding and applications of equal quality, applications submitted by first-time applicants will be given priority.

The duration of the project must be entirely within the time of your employment at WU. Applications may also be submitted for projects already running at the time of application, however, the risk of liability for all expenses already incurred is borne by the researcher in charge of the project.

Please keep the [grant conditions](#) in mind!

Not applicable for funding: Events, guest lecturers, travel expenses, printing and translation expenses, and remuneration of WU employees. Expenses for literature and equipment are not subject to funding, since most of the necessary equipment is available for loan at WU. The researcher's own work is also not subject to funding.

Application: only via [electronic application portal english](#)

Please include the following:

- short description of the project (objectives, methods)
- schedule and budget plan
- short description of yourself (CV and list of publications)

Decision: Decisions are made by the Vice-Rector for Research after a hearing with junior faculty representatives during a Senate meeting; please allow approx. 6-8 weeks for processing.

Payment: Payment request submitted in writing to Susanne Tacha, Financial Control, tel. 31336 ext. 4459; subject to accounting and reporting obligations (see Third Party Funding Office)
