WU (Vienna University of Economics and Business) is now inviting applications for the position of a **Professor (tenure-track) in Management Information Systems ("Wirtschaftsinformatik") with special focus on Financial Services and Accounting** at the Department of Information Systems and Operations. The position is defined for 5 years with the perspective of transforming it into a permanent position (at the level of full professor) after positive evaluations during the initial period.

It offers a broad range of subjects in all areas of economics and business administration. The University is looking for applicants who are interested in how IT can transform business processes with special focus on financial services and accounting. Applicants

- (a) must possess a solid academic qualification (e.g. PhD, *Habilitation*);
- (b) must demonstrate a record of success and continuing promise in scholarly research in Management Information Systems (Wirtschaftsinformatik) in general, focusing on business applications in financial services or accounting; international research experience preferred;
- (c) experience in generating research funding is preferable.

WU views this as a position for a professor in an early stage of his or her career who has a high commitment and ability to lead in order to substantially contribute to the Department's research and teaching activities, with particular emphasis on the targeted application areas. The candidate will be responsible for teaching Information Systems (Wirtschaftsinformatik) at the bachelor, master, and PhD levels, as well as in executive education programs. Since most of the courses are held in English, teaching experience in English is required, teaching experience in German is not necessary. Non German-speaking candidates are expected to acquire proficiency in German over a certain period of time.
