The new professor will join the faculty of the Department of Economics and is expected to cultivate an environment of excellence and collaboration to augment the Department's research, teaching, and service activities. The successful candidate's research should focus on the fields of labor economics and policy from an applied microeconomic perspective.

Applicants should have a) a solid academic qualification (PhD, habilitation degree) in the relevant fields; b) an outstanding publication record in the relevant fields; c) notable experience in empirical research using cutting-edge methods; d) a notable record in attracting and conducting third-party funded research, and e) a demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching.

The successful candidate will be teaching in programs and supervising theses at all levels (bachelor, MSc, PhD, executive education) and is expected to take an active role in the University's self-governance.

Non-German-speaking candidates are expected to acquire proficiency in German over a certain period of time.
