

B) What we expect from the successful candidate

The successful candidate is expected to perform teaching activities at all levels (bachelor's, master's, PhD/doctorate, and executive education), both in the classroom and in distance-learning formats. Full professors are expected to teach eight weekly credit hours.

Specifically, we expect the new colleague to contribute to WU's teaching programs in the field of Digital Economy (on bachelor's and master's level) in terms of program leadership and teaching in the core program. Furthermore, we expect the new colleague to contribute to the Research Institute of Cryptoeconomics and its activities in the Austrian Blockchain Center in terms of project leadership and research collaboration.

We also expect the new professor to take an active role in the university's self-governance and third mission activities.
