


BBE graduates have access to the same occupational fields as BESS (WISO) graduates.

Most BBE graduates continue their studies with a master's program - either at WU or at a renowned university abroad.







Hard work in the first year pays off





More than 30 ECTS credits in the first year

Only about 12 out of 100 students drop out, 88 successfully complete their studies.



Less than 30 ECTS credits in the first year of study

Approximately 85 students drop out, only 15 graduate.




