- 30 minutes before the start of the commencement ceremony, all graduates gather for a briefing located in the Ceremonial Hall 2. The briefing will include a detailed description of the ceremony's structure and schedule.
- After the briefing, a professional photographer will take a group photo of the graduates and the Master of Ceremonies.

- Start of the graduation ceremony -

- The graduates enter the room in alphabetical order
- The Master of Ceremonies enters the room to musical accompaniment *J Gaudeamus igitur J*
- The Master of Ceremonies greets the guests and delivers the commencement address.

After saying the pledge, please receive your diploma from the Master of Ceremonies. Once again, photos will be taken by a professional photographer.
