The **goal** of the program is to successfully pass a B2-level German exam so that you can enroll as a **student at WU**. The program will help you attain the necessary **B2-level German skills** to pass the exam.

To help you save as much time as possible, you need to take at least **1 MORE course** at WU Vienna. Credit for this and any other courses you may have completed can be transferred towards your WU degree program as **regular university courses** after enrollment.

Please note: These courses are intended for potential WU students.




- Personal data (name, home address, date of birth)

- Scan of school leaving certificate and/or proof of admission to university, transcript/grade record from the home university
- Proof of refugee status



B) July / August 2016

- The certificates are checked at the Study Service Center (LC building, level 2)
- You are issued your MORE ID card
- You are invited to take the placement test

Early September 2016: Language placement test (level B1 on September 6, level A2 on September 8)

Mid-September 2016: Notification of admission status

After successfully passing the B2-level exam at a language school, and if you have successfully participated in the admission procedure and fulfill the formal requirements for admission, you can enroll in the regular Bachelor's Program in Business, Economics and Social Sciences. Credit for MORE and any other courses you may have completed can be transferred towards your WU degree program.
