







Remote Care Assist (RCA)

Provides training and assistance for on-site care workers

- direct video and audio communication
- · enables an third person to assist in various situations on-site

Two components:

(i) Care Expert Center (CXC)


Organisational unit & web app for care experts



(ii) Remote Support Apps (RS) AR/MR app for MS HoloLens and smartphones







Remote Assistance for Home Care Workers



Main features:

- Video + audio call (GDPR conform)
- Screensharing & image transmission
- Screenshots & 2D marking
- 3D marking
- Documentation interface
- Visual ruler

Primarily used for:

- Wound care
- Dispensing medication
- Care documentation








Useful use cases

- Wound care (staff & experts) & training on the job (staff)
 - "Yes, it was good as support. I got some good tips from the nurse. Yes, and also with the wound progress control,
 where I sometimes don't know what kind of wound it is. Because once I called the wound manager and she explained it to
 me. That was great." (B4, L211-215)
- Medication issues (staff)
- Get insights into the work environment (households) (experts)
 - "It's not just related to the wound, but other situations as well, yes? [...] Interaction between spouses, married couples, for example." (X1, L45-48)

Problematic target groups

- Care service users with dementia or hearing problems
- Not care workers but nursing staff

Requirements for a successful implementation

- Technological: Linkage to the care documentation
- Organisational: Experts must be accessible (regional or supra-regional); workplace & workflow
- Implementation: Training for all eligible staff
- Policy: Funding for technological innovations for home care / regional internet connection.

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
