

Using LPIS

Transfer the following verbal description into an EPC:

- a) To register for a course, a student has to log in LPIS. For this he has to enter his immatriculation number and his password.
- b) When the wrong combination is entered the system counts how often it was wrong. After the third try, the account is blocked for half an hour. The process ends.
- c) If the combination is right, the system forwards the student to the main menu.
- d) There, the student can choose between the grades menu, the courses menu and the exams menu or can log out.
- e) If the student wants to see his grades, he chooses the grades menu. There he gets an abstract of his grades on the screen. Afterwards he chooses how to proceed - he can print the page or go back to the main menu. After printing, the student can choose again how to proceed.
- f) If the student wants to sign up /unsubscribe to a course, he chooses the courses menu. Then he has to choose how to proceed. He can go back to main menu or sign up/unsubscribe to a course. When the second case applies, the student chooses a curriculum point. If there are courses available, he can choose the course and, as a result, he is signed up/unsubscribed. If there are no courses available, the student has to make the initial decision about how to proceed again.
- g) If the student wants to change exams, he chooses the exams menu. There he gets a page showing all possible exams. Then he chooses how to proceed. He can either register/deregister for an exam or he go back to the main menu.
- h) If the student chooses to log out from LPIS, the process is over.
