In order to be awarded both degrees, the following requirements apply:



Language Course	Internship	Thesis	
CLSBE students have to pass a third language course (no specific level). Language courses at CLSBE are currently available in Portuguese, Spanish, Mandarin and German (course offer subject to annual update).	In order to be awarded both degrees, students are required to complete an internship of at least 6 weeks (240 hours). The internship can include several experiences of at least 80 hours each.	Students are required to write a thesis during the second year of their studies. All students need a thesis supervisor. CLSBE students going to WU will have a supervisor at WU.	
In order to waive the language requirement one of the following conditions have to be fulfilled:	The internship can be in Portugal, Austria, or anywhere else in the world.	Students will have to defend their theses at CLSBE. The defense at CLSBE takes place in July or in October.	
- Provide the original certificate of a language course of (at least) 40 hours with a final passing grade from a language school such as Alliance Française, Instituto Cervantes etc.	Prior professional experience can be used to satisfy this requirement (however it has to be subject to validation by the Careers & Talent Office at CLSBE), if completed after June 1 of the year prior to the beginning of the MSc program.	CLSBE students who want to finish the double degree program within four semesters and who want to take part in the optional graduation ceremony (Sponsion) at WU in October/November have to defend their thesis at CLSBE in the July graduation session.
