

Course structures for WU Students going to QUT

WU students undertaking the QUT double degree will study at QUT in Semester 6 and 7 (February to November) of their curriculum. At QUT, Students will complete the BS05 Bachelor of Business and will be awarded a B.Bus (major) from QUT. From WU, students will be awarded a BSc (WU). Both titles will be awarded after completion of all components of the study program.

WU students will be able to study any of the following Study Areas (majors) at QUT:

- Economics
- Finance
- Human Resource Management
- International Business
- Management
- Marketing

Students should nominate their preferred major to QUT at the point of application.

WU students selecting particular QUT majors are **required to use some elective study** at WU to undertake required prerequisite study for the QUT major.
