Students' Package

A thorough preparation and the willingness to learn together are an important basis to ensure the success of an International Summer University Program. This is a shared responsibility of both WU and WU students:

WU's responsibilities:

- Organization of the academic program (incl. pre-course assignment), the two mandatory preparatory meetings, as well as the credit transfer options (except external ISU programs TBA)
- Confirmation of IBW international experience
- Providing course materials (except external ISU programs TBA)
- Foreign travel health insurance (except external ISUs TBA)
- Accommodation: please see the fact sheet of the individual ISU program online
- Providing meals: please see the fact sheet of the individual ISU program online

Students' responsibilities:

- Participation fee payment within one week after nomination (=assignment)
- Bearing the costs for visa (if applicable)
- Observing the general code of conduct applicable to all WU students during a WU exchange program abroad (please see *notifications and data protection*)
- Taking the pre-course exam and attending the two mandatory preparatory meetings (except external ISUs TBA)
- Regular class attendance and punctuality, willingness to participate in class, team and group works, and willingness to cooperate with other students of partner universities
- Participation in the course and program evaluation process
- On-schedule arrival and check-in prior to the start of program (one day before lecture day at the latest)
