## QUICK REFERENCE CARD

### FREE TEXT SEARCH

Narrow down your search by filtering on one data category if this has not been set after entering text – coca cola.

Click the Explore link to open Explorer option or use <shift> + E on the keyboard. Use the Up/Down and Right/Left keys

RESULTS PAGE

Re-display previously reviewed explorers and searches.

Click to display the Preview Pane.

Re-order by start date, etc.

ADVANCE SEARCH PAGE

Select the Advance Search link

Select field (mnemonic) and type of search – contains, starts with,

Enter the text to search on – note: special characters such as \$ and £ are only supported in the Mnemonic and RIC fields

RESULTS PAGE

Search can be edited directly – e.g, change to CNPER.A

Or click on Advance Search again to make further changes or use other fields.
