read!t allows you to create clearly structured reading lists for your courses quickly and easily




read!t makes it easy to check the library collection for titles on the reading list



read!t offers multimedia features and allows you to add comments and tags


Implementation

- WU University Library in collaboration with Digital Teaching Services
- Orientation towards reference projects in English-speaking countries; WU is the first university in Austria implementing a reading list management system
- First pilot phase during summer term 2020; extended availability in winter term 2020/2021 activation directly in MyLEARN starting with January 2021



Creating reading lists easily (1/2)

- User-friendly interface
(Icons, drag-and-drop)
- Add resources easily
 - ❖ Search the WU library holdings
(print & electronic) and add a title
 - ❖ Pick references from databases,
websites, etc.
 - ❖ Search with ISBN, ISSN
 - ❖ Add a title manually





 - ❖ Additional Reading
- Other possibilities for structuring your list:
 - ❖ Subject specific
 - ❖ Chronological
 - ❖ According to resource type
