Abstract

The OECD, the European Commission and Governments worldwide are keeping pace with the evolving tax & customs laws and governance frameworks. There are multiple drivers like tax authorities perspective for transparency and extended reporting standards, public procurement agencies for B2G obligations and digitalization agencies e.g. for domestic B2B standards. These various discussions are going on and create rules and regulations that will create further complexity with regards to global, regional and domestic tax compliance. Therefore it is very important to focus on the ERP-landscape and to ensure data quality and also granularity to implement proper reporting processes and to minimize noncompliance risks.

With a view to the current SAP S/4HANA transformation projects, there is an opportunity for companies to optimize and standardize their tax reporting. This both in SAP Core (core application) and via additional tax applications (like SAP Tax Compliance, SAP Document Reporting Compliance).

General Information

The seminar lasts two days and takes place in Vienna from **June 13-14, 2022**. The seminar is entirely held in **English**.

In order to guarantee a high degree of interactivity, the course is strictly limited to a **maximum of 30 participants**.

The course is structured into four sessions per day of 1.5 hours each. The topics are analyzed with a mix of theory and project work with expert coaching.

Target Group

The seminar is targeted at professionals around the world who want to broaden their knowledge of tax law technology i.e. digitalization and automation. Participants typically are tax & customs advisers (accountants, economists, and lawyers), in-house tax & customs and finance employees of international companies, government officials, and academics.
